- National and Provincial officials with a LED Mandate (Department of Agriculture, Department of Land Affairs, Arts and Tourism etc.)
- Business and Sector organizations and office bearers (Business Chambers, Farmers Unions, Manufacturing Associations, Community Tourism Organisations, Sector Clusters and Networks
- Development and Finance Institutions working in the province of KwaZulu-Natal (Development Agencies, IDC, Commercial banks etc
- Senior Office bearers and officials of Civil Society organizations with an LED mandate

As LED is an integrative discipline, the entrance requirement for the Post-Graduate Diploma is an undergraduate degree or equivalent from any discipline. The Masters Programme requires a 3 year undergraduate degree plus honours or an equivalent further qualification, or a four year professional degree.
